Greetings Jorge Martins,

Congratulations. Your abstract titled “**Attitudes, knowledge, opinions, and practice of physicians and dentists toward obstructive sleep apnea syndrome and snoring**” number **A-1055-0019-01212** has been accepted to be presented as a **POSTER** at the upcoming World Sleep 2019 congress in Vancouver, Canada. Your poster session is scheduled for **Sunday, September 22, 2019 from 4:30PM to 6:00PM in Ballroom B**. You will be notified of your poster number approximately two weeks before the congress.

The poster surface area is 4 foot horizontal wide by 4 foot vertical tall (1.2192 meters by 1.2192 meters). Final size of poster can be determined by the author. Each poster must have a top label indicating the title of the paper and names of the authors. Additional details on abstracts can be found below or at <https://worldsleepcongress.com/abstracts>.

We have extended the registration deadline and current rates to **August 20, 2019**. All abstract presenters (presenting author) must be registered for the congress by August 20, 2019. Failure to register by August 20, 2019 will result in the abstract being rejected and the presenting author being disqualified to submit scientific content for two years. Failure to present the abstract on the assigned date will also result in the presenting author being disqualified to submit scientific content to future World Sleep congresses for two years. Please see the congress website for all policies and guidelines. If you do not intend to present your abstract at World Sleep 2019, please send a written request to withdraw the abstract prior to August 20, 2019.

Abstract changes can be made between August 15 and September 25, 2019 by logging into the author’s online abstract submission account. Abstracts will be published in a supplement of *Sleep Medicine Journal* and available online in December 2019.

Guidelines for Poster Presentation at World Sleep 2019

1. The poster surface area is 1.2192 meters by 1.2192 meters (4' x 4'). The final size of the poster can be determined by each author.
2. Each poster must have a top label indicating the title of the paper, the names of the authors and their affiliations.
3. The size of the font characters for the title should be large enough to be viewed at a distance of 2 meters (6 feet).
4. Tape will be provided for you to affix posters to the display boards. Other adhesive methods may be accepted if brought in by the author.
5. Authors may hand out information sheets to those viewing the poster.
6. Charts, drawings, and illustrations may be used within the poster.
7. Posters should be printed on paper or laminated paper. Do not use heavy cardboard or other heavy materials for mounting.
8. "Introduction" and "Conclusion" sections are preferred. When feasible, use graphs for demonstrating qualitative relationships, tables of precise numerical values. Photographs should be printed on non-glossy matte finish paper.
9. Do not mail poster presentations to the convention center.
10. Do not fold posters. Instead, transport the poster in an appropriate container.
11. World Sleep Society staff and/or volunteers will be present to assist with locating poster boards and mounting.

Additional Abstract Details

- The cost of printing the poster is the responsibility of the author(s).
- Final date and time of presentation will be finalized on or before July 31, 2019.
- Poster numbers will not be assigned until September 2019. Numbers will be communicated via forthcoming email.
