You will need to refer to these numbers in all further correspondence as well as to identify your poster location.

General Information

We have scheduled dedicated poster viewing times, in which posters will be on display Monday, June 13 – Wednesday, June 15. Each poster will be displayed for one day only. Posters will be displayed by

themed sessions in Exhibit Hall C of the Minneapolis Convention Center. Poster setup is from 7:00am – 8:00am on the day of your presentation. Your poster board ID number will enable you to determine the location of your poster in the viewing room. A map will be available in the SLEEP 2011 Final Program to assist you as well. Removal of your poster may begin at 5:00pm on your presentation day. **Do not remove your poster prior to 5:00pm.** Posters that are not removed by 6:00pm will be discarded.

Participants will have the opportunity to view and discuss posters during viewing times (10:15am – 12:15pm). Each author should be present at his or her poster during the poster viewing time on the day your poster will be displayed. Authors of **odd-numbered** poster board ID numbers should be present at your poster display from 10:15am – 11:15am. Authors of **even-numbered** poster board ID numbers should be present at your poster display from 11:15am – 12:15pm. If the two-hour poster presentation is an insufficient amount of time, presenters are encouraged to continue their presentation into the lunch hour.

Criteria

Posters should be clear and organized for viewing posters, measuring no larger than 4' x 4'. The following article provides an excellent description of elements that comprise a readable poster: Woolsey, J.D., "Combating Poster Fatigue: How to Use Visual Grammar and Analysis to Effect Better Visual Communication," *Trends in Neuroscience*, 1989, 12(9), pp. 325-332.

While planning your poster presentation, please remember the following guidelines:

- Logos promoting commercial companies are prohibited.
- Posters may include tables and graphs.
- Posters should be clear and organized for viewing.
- Use of laptops during poster presentations is prohibited.
- Authors are responsible for ensuring that they have received permission to include any copyrighted information in their posters.

Confidentiality

All presenters are required to follow professional guidelines for patient confidentiality. No photos, names, records, or other patient identifiers may be included in your poster unless you have obtained appropriate approval.

Meeting Registration/Hotel Reservation

Each abstract presenter must be registered for the meeting. The preliminary program, which is available online at www.sleepmeeting.org and will be mailed to members in early March, includes the meeting registration form. **Registration is also available via the SLEEP 2011 website at www.sleepmeeting.org.** Register on or before April 27, 2011, to receive advanced registration rates.

Hotel reservation information will be included in the preliminary program and is currently available on the SLEEP 2011 website. We strongly encourage you to make hotel reservations early. This year's co-headquarter hotels are the Hyatt Regency Minneapolis and the Hilton Minneapolis.
